Snow conditions, however, were rather less than ideal. Most long valley runs are closed for lack of snow, and everywhere in the Alps people are anxiously awaiting new snowfalls.

This is an important exhibition, brought to New Zealand by Pro Helvetia, Arts Council of Switzerland, and should be of great interest to every age group - it is a photographic history of the world that is our's.
