However, it is a concern that some members seem to believe that, by publishing these contact details, the individuals offer an information service about Switzerland that goes a long way beyond the remit of the Society, or that they have contacts and influence beyond those that could realistically be expected. The bulk of enquiries fall upon the Editor and our Swiss News Editor who put in considerable time and effort to produce this magazine. Unfortunately they do not have the time or resources to respond to enquiries about aspects of travel in Switzerland, or members' specialised transport interests. There are many commercial and Internet sources to supply such information. Nor, unlike some members' assumptions, do either of them or any of the Board have contacts in the senior management of the SBB - or the telephone number of the Swiss Ambassador! If you have questions about Switzerland, or its transport infrastructure, that you cannot find information about, consider submitting a letter for inclusion in *Swiss Express*. Other SRS members have a wealth of knowledge that could answer them. Finally I wish you all a very pleasant Christmas and a great 2018. ☑
