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## Guidelines for contributors (state of January 1st 1991)

(Addition to the "Printing Rules for Eclogae geologicae Helvetiae", Eclogae geol. Helv. 71/2, 1978, 441–445).

Manuscripts. Three copies of the manuscript ready for printing, each accompanied by copies of all illustrations, should be sent to the editor of Eclogae (address see below). They should be typed on one side of paper, double spaced and with ample margins. The full postal address(es) of the author(s) should be included as footnotes. A short running title (max. 50 characters) should be provided.

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For preferred use of stratigraphic terminology and nomenclature the reader is referred to the Code of Stratigraphic Nomenclature (ACSN, 1961) in Bull. Am. Ass. Petroleum Geologists, 45, 454–459, as well as to the recommendations of the Schweizerische Geologische Kommission in Eclogae geol. Helv. 66/2, (1973), 479–492\*. Paleontological names (genus and species) should be underlined in black to be printed in italics. Biological citation rules should be respected (see also Eclogae geol. Helv. 64/3, 641–643 or 649–651).
