● RECIPE

We are happy to be favoured by Max Bachmann with a series of popular Sausage recipes of interest to readers, the first of which is—

Buure-Bratwurst

- 10 lbs streaky pork (belly-neck)
- 4 lbs veal or beef, not fat, or
- 2 lbs veal and 2lbs calf and pig's heart
- $\frac{1}{2}$ lb onion.

Mince veal or beef through fine (3mm) plate and mix with pork and mince through 4mm plate, then add (per 10 lbs): 120 gms salt; 5 gms pepper; 3 gms nutmeg; 1 gm cloves; Maggi; 1 pint milk (mix in slowly, not too much at a time); 1 or 2 eggs.
