Date: 6th June 1971.

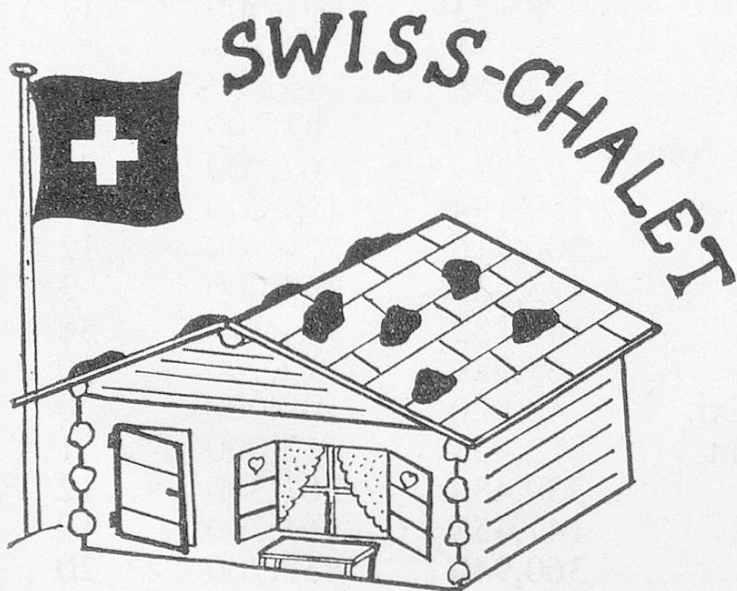
Place: Riccarton House, Kahu Road, Christchurch.
