Over 800 sq.m. of packed shelves are stocked with everything that may please the most discerning pets from goldfish to St Bernards. The only thing not sold at this supermarket are the animals themselves.

BUNDESPLATZ BERNE

The "Bundesplatz" in Berne should no longer be used only as a car park. A competition has been started by the City of Berne and the Federal Government to find ideas as to the best use of the area.

Up to now the "Bundesplatz" has been mainly used as a car park and, on some days, as a mart (Zibelemärit) and often too as a place for demonstrations. The competition produced 207 entries of which 3 have been retained for further studies. Whatever the improvements to the "Bundesplatz" will be, they will not be taking place before 1995.

FLOATING CINEMA ON THE BODENSEE

The Swiss Railways have inaugurated a world first by launching a floating cinema on the Bodensee. Every Friday one of the ferries, the "Romanshorn", becomes a cinema for 400 passengers. All films have a nautical theme such as "Fisherin vom Bodensee", "Schiff der Träume", "Africa Queen", "Three Men in a Boat" and "Blue Lagoon".
