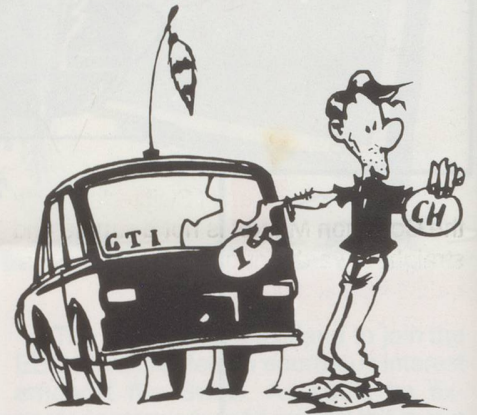
Once again the Editor wishes to sincerely thank Swissair, all the staff of the Embassy of Switzerland in Wellington

DUAL NATIONALITY



Italy has at long last accepted the principle of dual nationality, which means that the 25.000 Italians who became Swiss citizens over the years can now demand their Italian nationality back. It has taken all this time since the end of the second world war to abolish this old 1912 law.
