from advertising is expected to have at best a minimal effect.

The search for alternative finance has led the Organisation of the Friends of the OSA to suggest an individual life membership proposal costing no less than Fr. 500.-- (see Swiss Revue, 5/97). My personal opinion (for what it's worth) is that 500 Francs may be small change for some, but for the large majority, this sort of money just doesn't grow on trees!! Therefore, other alternatives must be found. It is my intention to raise this question at the next AGM, hopefully to create some meaningful discussions and to come up with some possible workable solutions.

Citizenship

If I understood the situation correctly, Swiss Citizens who took on another nationality prior to World War II lost their original Swiss nationality. It now appears that there has been a change in thinking - descendants of Swiss born parents who lost their nationality in this way, and born before 31.12.53, are advised to contact the Embassy. There is a good possibility that they are able to now acquire Swiss Citizenship.

Secretariat

Following the Congress, I accepted an invitation by Dr. R. Wyder, Director of the Secretariat, for a general discussion. It transpired that the Swiss Society of New Zealand is looked upon as an important and very active group within the OSA. In return, I was able to give Dr. Wyder a better picture of our organisation here particularly regarding the vari-

ous activities held by the Clubs, and the support they receive from their members. It is quite possible that Dr. Wyder may pay us a visit at some stage in the not too distant future.

I also had a discussion with a long-time advertiser in the HELVETIA and good friend to many - Bruno Böckli from *Oceania Reisen*. I will report on the outcome of this at the next AGM.

Overall, I feel that the annual Congress is an important medium to keep up contact with the old country, both culturally and politically. The only negative aspect I found was that the agenda submitted to Delegates was too cramped, giving individuals insufficient opportunity to raise points of concern. One must also take into account that most Delegates have resided abroad for many years and are no longer a conversant with the spoken "high German" as they once were (myself included!) The two languages used during the debates were German and French, therefore, for those unable to speak either, there was very little opportunity to take part in any of the discussions.

Federal Councillor Adolf Ogi was the only person to address the Congress in English: Kandersteg-English, that is!! There were only two or three paragraphs, but it was a much appreciated effort. (I have his speech in full for anyone who is interested.)
