

Here are some clues to identify the Canton for the competition; The names of the Canton and the Capital are the same. The cantonal flag shows a small white cross in the top-right corner in a red field. This Canton was one of the founding Cantons of the Federation. There are approx. 106,000 inhabitants in this Canton. The highest point of 2802 m. is the "Bös Fulen" and the lowest point is along the lake of Zürich, 406 m. The Capital of this Canton boasts the federal museum/archive where the federal constitution is kept and exhibited.
