1923 - 2002

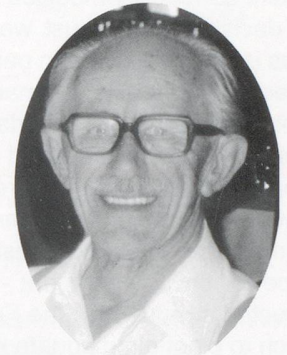

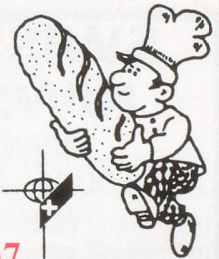
