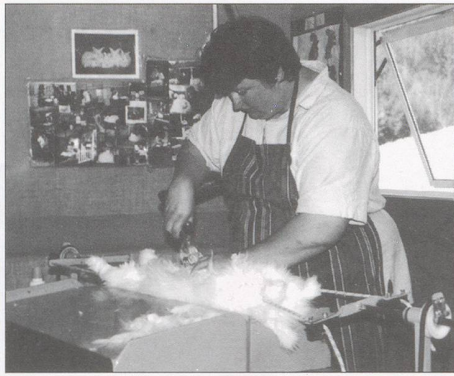


## Editorial

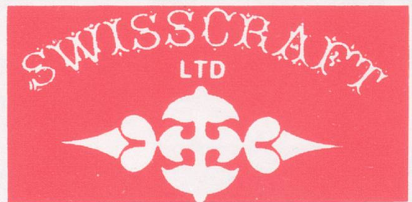
