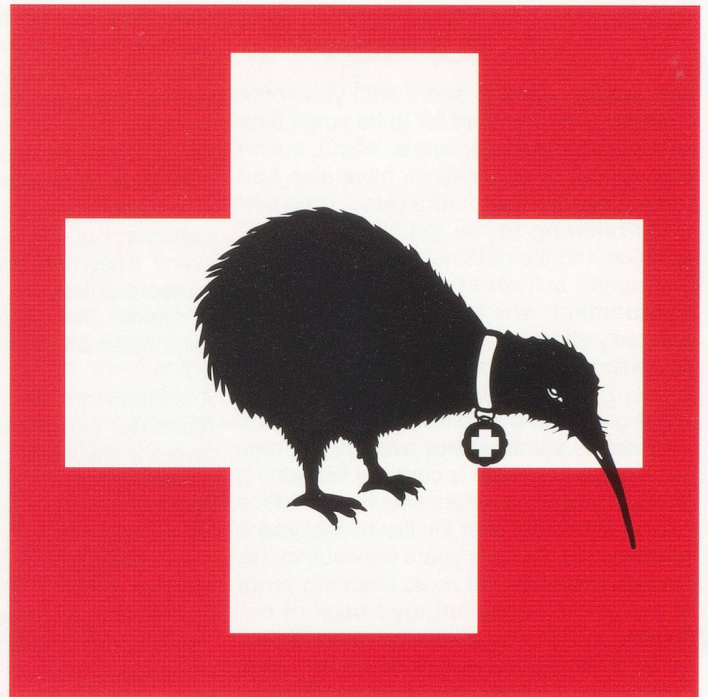

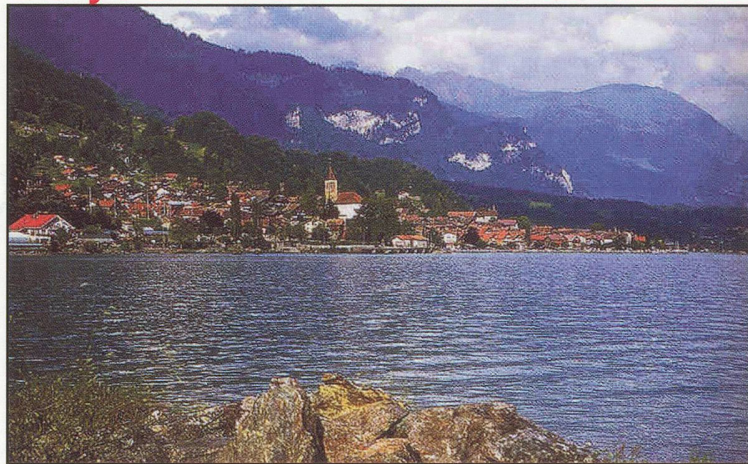

The town and the mountain in the background have the same name as the lake.

Lying east of Interlaken and the Thunersee, the clear waters of the .....see stretch out in a setting of forested slopes and waterfalls, with majestic mountains rising in the background. Some 14 km long and almost 3 km wide at its broadest point, the .....see is slightly smaller than the Thunersee and much less developed, with fewer sports centres lining
