Walter and Agnes bought their first farm at Taupiri and added Gregory, Anton and Gerard to the family. They moved to a Huntly farm and in 1983 they moved into town, to retire.

Not that they ever really retired! They were still a very busy couple. Agnes' cooking abilities range from traditional kiwi tucker to Swiss baking treats. Walter with his tractor and baler has been spotted around town for years doing odd jobs for small lifestyle block owners. The tractor, much to Walter's disappointment, had to be sold recently. A grandson has bought it to restore it to its former glory.

Walter and Agnes have also been active in the Hamilton Swiss Club. Walter made and donated many wood carvings towards Swisscard evening prizes. 
