Most of you receive the magazine "Swiss Revue", the magazine for the Swiss abroad, either by post or by email. Up until now the New Zealand regional news has been included in the general "News from around the World" section and was mixed with information from Africa, Asia and parts of Europe.

Onwards from January 2015 the regional news from Australia and New Zealand will be combined in a new issue called "Oceania" (located inside the printed version of the "Swiss Revue" and on a separate link in the online version). The Swiss Embassy in Wellington is also responsible for diplomatic and consular relations with the Republic of Fiji, the Cook Islands, Samoa, The Kingdom of Tonga and Tuvalu, as well as for consular relations with Niue and American Samoa.

Information from and for the Swiss community in these states will also be included in the "Oceania" issue. There are currently about 7000 "Swiss Revues" that are distributed through the New Zealand Embassy.

In the past Australia published their own region specific news. They have now kindly agreed to share some of that space with us. For the Swiss living in New Zealand this is a very exciting change.


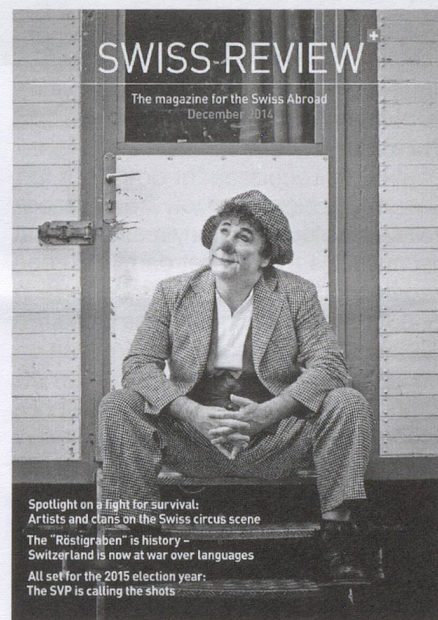
Amongst the Swiss clubs it was decided that the Swiss Society, who also produces the Helvetia,
