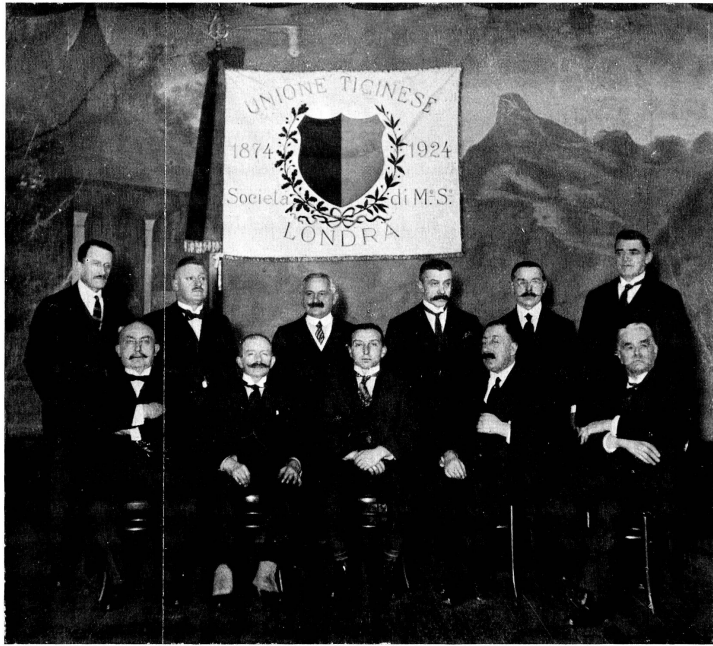

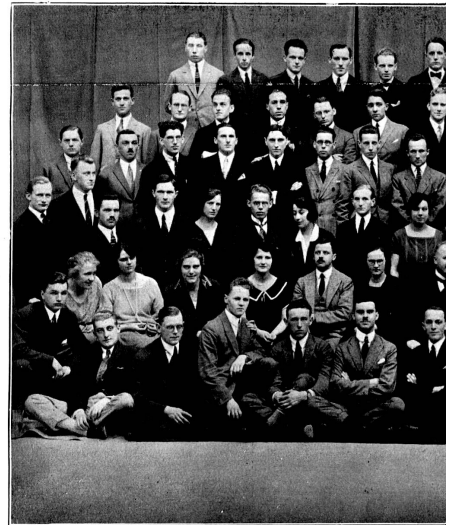

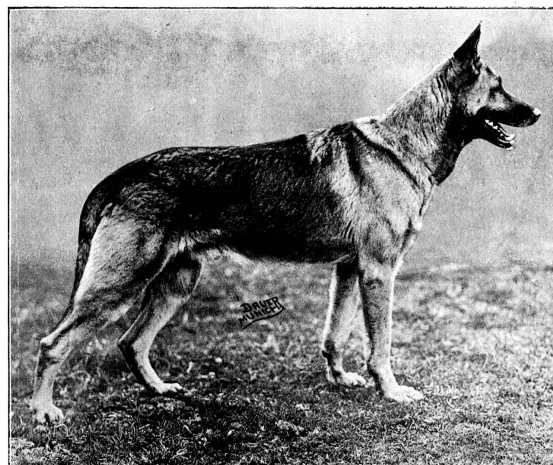
The above photograph of the SWISS MERCANTILE CLUB, last, shows the rapid growth which took place since its formation. Its attendance during the last year was 70 to 100; since
