Still the same three leaders in the National League, all having now played 21 games, with Grasshoppers 33 points, Bern 32 and Servette 31, fourth Basel, 27 points. At the tail end, we still have Zurich, who, by the way, could not raise the funds for their eleven to travel to Geneva to play Urania (!); then Blue Stars, as before; but Nordstern, by two consecutive victories, are now only 1 point behind Locarno, with two games in hand. Plenty of time for them to get clear yet. Eight, nine and ten games respectively are still unsettled. It will be July, if not August, before they will finish. Balmly lot!

In the First League Carouge have won the leadership in Group West, and so after one season only in the lower house, the Geneva Club will return to the National League — a fine effort; congratulations.

In Group East Bellinzona inflicted on Kreuzlingen their first home defeat of the season, and thereby head the table with 18 points from 15 games; Kreuzlingen follows, 17 points, 13 games; third, St. Gallen, 17 points, 15 games; fourth, Brühl, 16 points, 14 games; fifth, Aarau, 15 points, 13 games. What a mix-up. Any of the five can finish on top or second by the time they have all completed their programme of 16 matches. Brühl have run into form with smashing victories over Aarau and their town rivals St. Gallen. My heart is too heavy for me to say more about that terrible 6-1 result. How could they? Winterthur's revival, I am afraid, has come too late; but it is nice to see there is life in the old lion yet.
