The English League programme of 42 matches is completed. In our National League 30 games are the full programme, and some clubs have still to play as many as 8 games! In the First League a mere 16 games are required, and whilst 8 of the 18 clubs have finished (Cheers!), of the other 10 one has 3 more, 2 have 2 more, and 7 have one more game outstanding! Etoile Ch.-de-F. and Winterthur, both old and famous clubs, past champions at that, are definitely last in their groups and relegated to League II. or oblivion. One other club will have to accompany them; who? That question still remains unanswered. Carouge, we repeat, have gained promotion, but in Group East, where Bellinzona has finished with 20 points. Aarau with 19, and Brühl with 18 points and one more game to play, can pass or catch up the present leader; and so can Kreuzlingen, with 17 points and 2 more games to play. Who will go up?

This is in the nature of a test match for our international team, which is due to play Holland on the 27th May, in Milan, in the first round for the World's Championship (so-called).

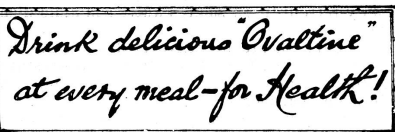
