AN APPEAL PUBLISHED IN THE "TIMES." THE BOSS FAMILY OF GRINDELWALD.

TO THE EDITOR OF THE TIMES.

Sir,—There must be many readers of *The Times*, no longer young, who, though not connected with mountaineering enterprise, yet remember with gratitude and affection the generation of the famous Boss family who founded and staffed the Bear Hotel in the seventies of the last century, and who brought it to the standing of a world-famed hostelry before it was burned to the ground in the early nineties.

The hotel, very inadequately insured, fell into other hands, and was rebuilt on a grandiose scale, some of the family being employed in its management. But these are now all dead and can no longer help the two remaining sisters who were not so employed, Cecile Boss, aged 70 and nearly blind, and her elder sister, the widowed Frau Arni, who have long lived frugally together in a two-roomed flat in Grindelwald on an income of £3 a week, £2 of which was contributed by Dr. Paul Arni, recently killed in a motor accident, thus depriving his mother of her sole means of support and reducing the joint income of the sisters by two-thirds. The Alpine Club has started a collection to help these unfortunate ladies, but the generation who knew the family is fast disappearing and it is hoped that a wider appeal may reach other sympathizers.
