We have much pleasure in publishing herewith a letter of acknowledgement, addressed to the Swiss Minister in London, by General Guisan:—

Pully/Lausanne, 2 avril 1947.

A la Légation de Suisse en Angleterre
Monsieur le Ministre Rüegger

Londres.

Monsieur le Ministre,

Le Département Politique Fédéral m'informe que l'appel de notre Légation à Londres en faveur de la "Fondation Général Guisan" a produit la belle somme de £390.13.10, c.à.d. Fr.6,750.—

Ce beau geste d'entraide des Suisses à l'étranger envers leurs camarades malades nous touche vivement. — Il est une nouvelle preuve de leur attachement au pays natal.—

Au nom des soldats malades qui, grâce à ce bel esprit de solidarité, pourront se soigner et se guérir au bon air de la montagne, je vous en remercie chaleureusement et vous prie de bien vouloir transmettre ma vive reconnaissance aux généreux donateurs.—
