U.S.S.R. HONOURS SWISS MATHEMATICIAN

The Praesidium of the Academy of Sciences of the U.S.S.R. recently awarded the 1968 Lobatchevski Prize to the Swiss mathematician Heinz Hopf for his work in the field of differential geometry and topology. This prize has been awarded every 3 years since 1947 for the best mathematical research work submitted by Soviet and foreign scientists. From 1959 to 1963 Professor Hopf, whose research has had a decisive influence on some of the essential principles of geometry, was President of the International Union of Mathematicians, which has its headquarters in Zurich.
