MR. GABRIEL GODET, 80

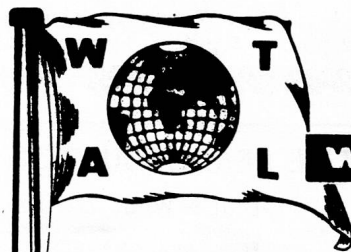
A special after-service "agape" with wine and cake was held in honour of Mr. Gabriel Godet on Sunday, 29th August. On that very day, Mr. Godet was 80 years old. He came to this country in 1916 after having served part of the 1914 mobilisation and briefly worked in Paris. He worked in London at the Credit Lyonnais and the Banca Commerciale Italiana.

His activities in the Swiss Colony were centered on the Swiss Church and the Swiss YMCA. He became a member of the Consistoire in 1924 and is still Honorary Member. For over 40 years he was the Church's Treasurer and he is one of the lasting, valiant members of the French-Swiss YMCA group in London, an association of Swiss Christians highly active in the past, particularly in the days of the late Alfred Braun.

Mr. Godet is still active with his visiting for the Church and his participation with the work of the Swiss Benevolent Society. He is busy in retirement, having acted as the "Gideon's" accountant until a few years ago, and working now at the Evangelical Library at Marylebone.

We should like to congratulate him most sincerely and wish him many more years of health and vitality.
