"GEORGE MIKES INTRODUCES SWITZERLAND'

The book "George Mikes introduces Switzerland", illustrated with many SNTO photographs, has been published by the firm of André Deutsch in London. The authors - journalists from major Swiss newspapers, university lecturers and writers from Switzerland, and other countries, such as Sergius Golowin, Paul Nizon and Irwin Shaw - have succeeded in conveying a vivid, accurate and realistic picture of Switzerland. The subjects dealt with include democracy and politics, history, geography, tourism, traditional customs, art, architecture and the special features of different regions and towns and cities. As an introduction, George Mikes, the famous writer and humorist who enjoys ever-increasing popularity in Switzerland, presents "homo helveticus" in all his uniqueness.

Immediately after his ordination to the priesthood in 1927, Fr. Matthew Ruf, of the Bethlehem Missionary Society, Immensee, Switzerland, went out to Manchuria as a missionary. After 20 years of varied and most successful missionary work, he was arrested by the communists and given a five-year prison sentence.

What he has gone through he tells in a touching, simple language, without heroism and pretence, without bitterness and revenge, accusing nobody and full of thanks to all who helped him. A real document of human life.
