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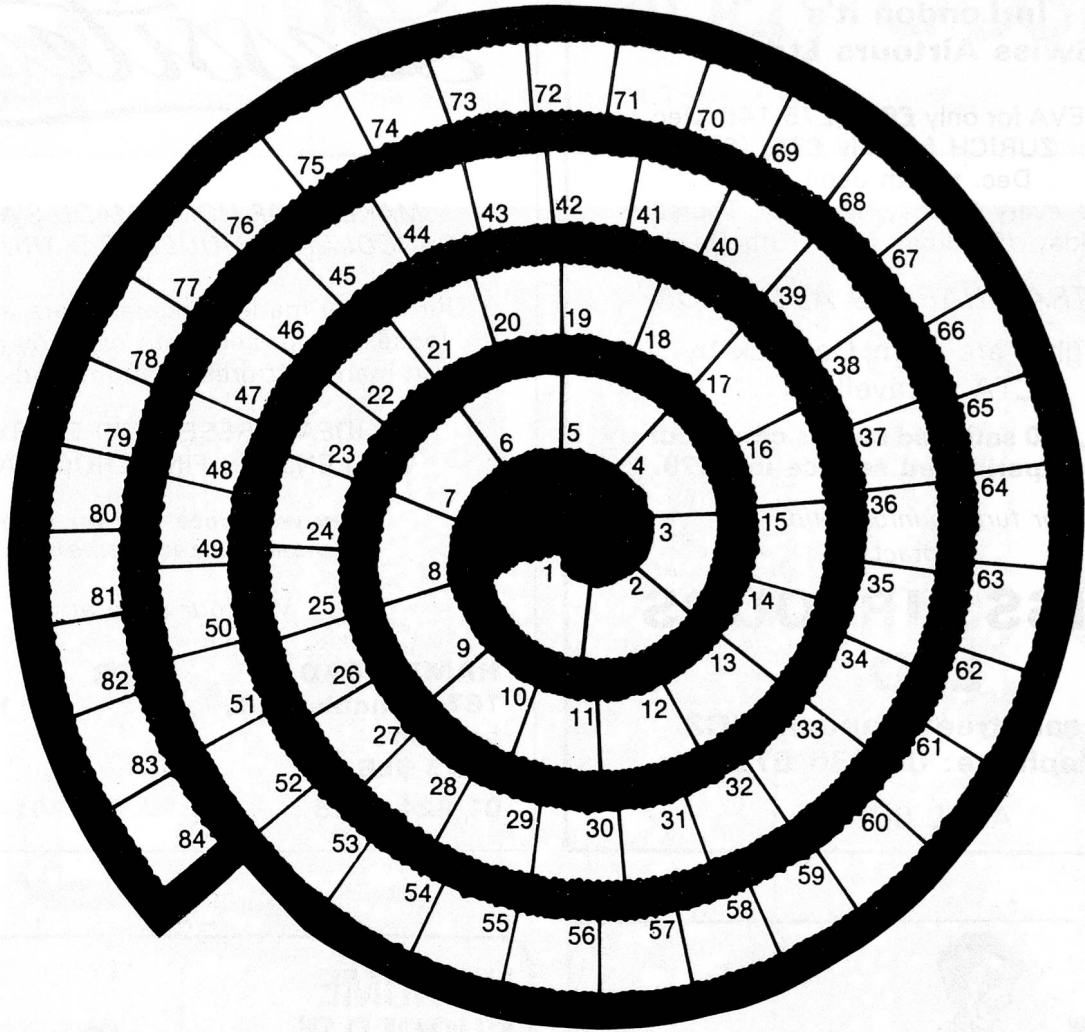
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Take a turn at the Swiss Roll

of the next word.

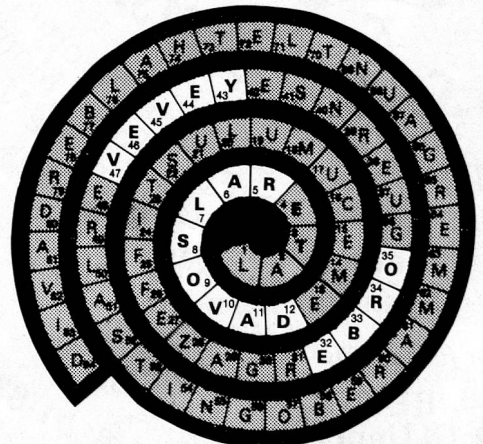
Hidden in the REVERSE reading are the names of three Swiss geographical features and the name of a Swiss wine.

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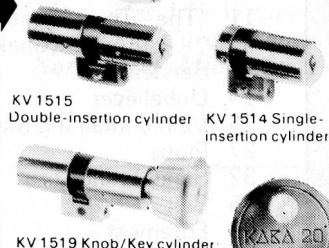
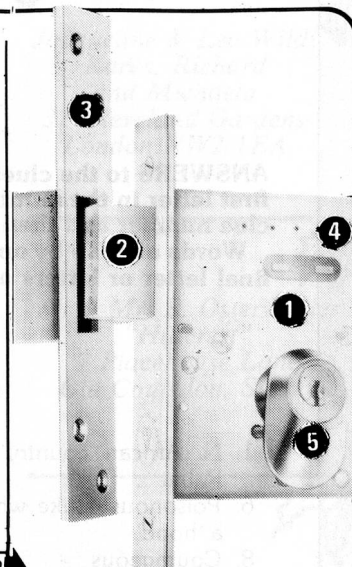
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
