Golden Pass.

A pictorial paperback book on the famous route from Lake Geneva to Lake Lucern, via the railways of the MOB, BLS and SBB Brünig. Text German and English. 96 pages. 86 full colour and 24 black and white illustrations.

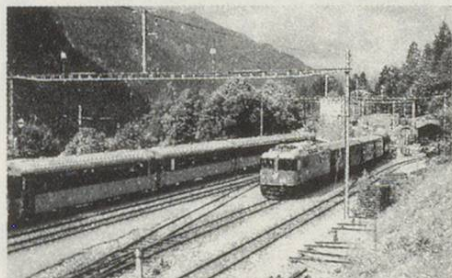
Preserved Locomotives Switzerland

The railway fleet lists/shed allocation booklets published by The Locomotive Club of Great Britain will be familiar to many members. They have recently (May 1988) published one entitled 'Preserved Locomotives Switzerland'. It takes the form of a Canton list of locations at which preserved locos, be they in running order or stuffed and mounted, are to be found. Each entry takes the form of a statement of gauge, company for which loco worked, name if any, number, wheel arrangement, classification, builder, works number and year of construction. There is also a brief list of Swiss locos preserved outside Switzerland. The Swiss loco/unit classification system is explained briefly but clearly. Altogether a useful, cheap and easy to use introduction to Swiss railway preservation.
