The International Railway Preservation Society will mark the occasion with the publication of a special bi-lingual souvenir book which will include new unpublished texts, photographs and railway memorabilia. This book is compiled by the team who have published books on The Compagnie des

Wagons-Lits and French Local Railways. Together with substantial contributions from historians in Dunkerque, Calais and Paris it promises to be an important addition to the history of this famous train, which offered a form of travel well before the Channel Tunnel was planned and built.
