n occasions members have received their copy of Swiss Express damaged in the post. When it is your copy, it is important. This has lead to the suggestion that we use plastic envelopes. The number of damaged deliveries are in fact very small, over a period of time, about 0.5%. The main problem is with the Post Office delivery staff not taking care. If you find this continues you should contact your local sorting office. Small style letter boxes can also be a problem.

To change to plastic would mean our printers having to out-source the mailings, incurring a greater cost to the Society. The printers said that they have received more complaints about plastic envelopes, as there can be a problem recycling them. Secondly, the insert address sheet, that carries information that is for members only, could be seen
