## Professor of Architecture and Design

(limited to 6 years)

The Department of Architecture ([www.arch.ethz.ch](http://www.arch.ethz.ch)) at ETH Zurich invites applications for the abovementioned position.

The new professor is responsible for teaching theoretical foundations, methodologies and specialized knowledge in the field of architectural design. He or she is responsible for running design courses in the 5th and 6th semesters of the Bachelor's degree course and in the Master's degree course (incl. master's thesis), taking into account areas such as history of architecture, manufacturing techniques, materials properties, economics and sustainable resource management. Design courses using integrated disciplines requires motivation and willingness to collaborate with other chairs among the department's institutes. Research activities cover topics of construction or planning practice, as well as architectural strategies for meeting the complex requirements of today's building industry. The work of the professorship is based on the range of the architect's professional responsibilities, building practices, and the state of development of construction technology. Cross-disciplinary collaboration is highly desirable.

Successful candidates should have a substantial architectural oeuvre. Additional qualifications usually include completed university studies, experience in teaching and research, as well as competence in construction technology and planning and implementing high-quality buildings. It is expected that the successful candidate will have a strong interest in shaping teaching work and in the constant further development of educational models. Additional duties include the leadership of a group of staff and the commitment to help develop the Department of Architecture beyond the boundaries of the specialty itself.

The new professor will be expected to teach undergraduate level courses (German or English) and graduate level courses (English).
